

# REDUCE - REUSE - RECYCLE 2017

## REFUSE COLLECTION

Waste collection in the village is weekly automated pick-up of 95-gallon carts on scheduled days. All materials eligible for refuse collection must be placed in the cart and any material **left outside or next to the cart will not** be collected. Place cart curbside or within seven feet of pavement edge by 6:00 am, but no sooner than noon of the previous day. Emptied carts shall be removed by 8:00 am the day following collection. Advanced Disposal Services will also take larger household items, up to 200 pounds. **Please call Advanced Disposal Services directly (262) 679-0860 to arrange pickup of items such as appliances, furniture, mattresses, carpet, etc. There is no additional charge for this service.**

***You may also utilize the online forum on their website [www.advanceddisposal.com](http://www.advanceddisposal.com) under the Customer Care tab (top menu) for special pickup requests (click on customer care form) and missed pickups (click on services form). Please do not call Village Hall; these instances must be reported directly to Advanced and noted in their log.***

## RECYCLING

Recycling collection in the village is bi-weekly with automated pick-up of 95-gallon carts. All materials eligible for recycling must be placed in the cart and any material **left outside or next to the cart will not** be collected. Simply wheel the carts to the roadside and a recycling truck will mechanically pick it up, empty the contents, and place it down; exactly where you left it. There is no need to separate recycling materials, just put them all in the cart. Advanced Disposal Services has exclusive control over recyclables placed curbside under Village Ordinance. Scavengers will be prosecuted under Section 14.23 of the Village Code.

### **Recycle:**

Plastics #1 through #7  
Glass bottles and jars  
Tin, bi-metal and aluminum cans  
Newspaper & miscellaneous household paper  
Magazines & phone books  
Cardboard (cut to fit into container)  
Foam PS (polystyrene) packaging  
Aseptic containers  
*Rinse all bottles & cans and remove lids.*

### **DO NOT recycle:**

plastic bags  
aluminum foil  
packing material  
motor oil containers  
frozen food boxes and any other paper product that has been soiled with food, such as used paper plates or pizza boxes.

## YARD WASTE/FALL LEAF PICKUP

Yard waste such as plants, twigs and small branches less than 6" diameter are picked up on **scheduled** days. Yard waste must be put in paper bags, boxes or trash containers. **Plastic bags will not be accepted** during yard waste pick-up dates. Small branches must be bundled. Bundles cannot exceed 1 foot in diameter and 4 feet in length. **Starting in November** and continuing for the remaining 5 pickups, the Village has made a special provision so that you may put your leaves and remaining yard waste in plastic bags no larger than 55 gallons. You may also use paper bags, cardboard boxes or trash containers. Weight shall not exceed 80 pounds. **OPEN BURNING OF LEAVES AND YARD WASTE IS PROHIBITED IN THE VILLAGE OF HALES CORNERS.**

## OFF - SITE DUMPING

Advanced Disposal's, Emerald Park Landfill allows our residents to dump items at their facility for a **FEE**.
