ORDINANCE NO. 11 - 09

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING CODE TO INCREASE THE SIZE OF
BUSINESS TRUCKS PARKED IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS

WHEREAS, the Village Board Committee of the Whole having recommended an amendment to the Zoning Code to increase the size of business trucks that may be parked in residential areas; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Village Board on the 10th day of October, 2011, upon the aforesaid proposed amendment and the Village Board thereafter having determined that the proposed regulation would promote the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Hales Corners, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 8-8-6(a) of the Zoning Code of the Municipal Code of the Village of Hales Corners, Wisconsin, is hereby amended as follows:

“(a) Truck Parking in Residential Areas. Passenger automobiles and panel, enclosed or pickup trucks for personal use. One (1) panel, enclosed, or pickup truck when used by the occupant in his business or occupation, in operable condition, shall be permitted in any residence district. Trucks shall be limited to those with a wheel base of one hundred thirty-nine (139) inches or less and a gross vehicle weight of ten thousand (10,000) pounds or less. No commercially licensed trailer, including semi-trailers, shall be parked or stored in a residential district, except when loading, unloading or rendering a service [Ref. Sec. 8-2-9(e)(2)].”

SECTION 2: The terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable. Should any term or provision of this ordinance be found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining terms and provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in contravention to this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
